ARROW IN! – A Note from the Principal

One of the most important ways to help your children succeed in school is to make them feel good about themselves. Kids who are confident are more likely to get good grades. Here are some ways to build self-esteem:

- **Give individual attention.** Spend regular one-on-one time with each of your children to build strong relationships.
- **Encourage your child's interests.** Notice things that make her special and do projects and activities together.
- **Display things your children make.** Laminate art or drawings and hang good grades on the refrigerator to let them know you are proud of their efforts.
- **Emphasize your child's strengths.** Look for opportunities to compliment him. And when you must criticize, do it helpfully - not hurtfully.
